The decisions of the PHS Booster Club committee are final and are based on a combination of the following criteria:

- School / community service and involvement (on a volunteer basis)
- Leadership in student / athletic activities
- Sportsmanship and school spirit
- Character and good citizenship
- Student essay
- Accepted or acceptance pending at an institute of higher learning

Applicants interested in applying for these scholarships should complete the following application, include a PDF of a transcript as of the end of 1st semester senior year, submit completed essay, and forward all forms/documents by 8:00pm **Saturday, February 15th, 2025**, via email to:
